**Plenary Council 2020**

*'More than ever before, we need the guidance and inspiration of the Holy Spirit as we engage in the task of renewing and re-energising the Church. We need a new Pentecost that will move us from decay to growth, from chaos to harmony, from disillusionment to joy. We need to find new fresh ways of being church that reflect authentically the person and message of Jesus and empower our people with fresh hope.'*

*Spoken by Bishop Vincent Long on Pentecost Sunday as he launched the Plenary Council in his diocese of Parramatta. These words speak clearly to us here in Adelaide also.*

The Second Vatican Council recommended that the Church should be more participatory in its processes, involving **all the baptised** in the Church. In light of this, the Bishops of Australia have invited all who are connected in any way with our Australian Catholic Church to participate in the **Plenary Council**. We are all being invited to consider how we can be the Jesus' presence and witness in our contemporary Australian society and discern the future that God is calling us to as a Church.

The first meeting of Plenary Council 2020 will be held in **Adelaide** from October 4-10, 2020. It will be an exciting new event for the Catholic Church in Australia. Preparation for this gathering involves **all of us** being invited to participate in a process of **listening and dialogue**.

**Here in our Hindmarsh – Findon Parish we will begin this process during Advent.** Over the coming weeks several parishioners will be invited to give a brief reflection at Mass on the question to which all associated with the Catholic Church in Australia are being asked to respond. This will provide relevant information for the Plenary Council. This question is

***"What do you think God is asking of us in Australia at this time?"***

**In February next year all parishioners** will be invited to gatherings in which you can participate in small groups to share and listen to others around this question. Already thousands of responses from across our country have been received by the Council: it is important that **each one of us** has the opportunity to speak and be listened to as we share our experiences and hopes for our Church. May we all be open to God's Spirit during this process.

**Todays feast of Christ the King celebrates Christ's reign over the human race and human hearts.**

The feast emphasises God's ultimate forgiveness as well as Christ's eschatological return and final sovereignty over all creation. This last theme is continued during Advent.



**Gospel Reflection**

**Christ the King** Dan 7:13-14; Rev 1:5-8; John 18:33-37

Kings and Queens are almost a thing of the past. In spite of that, we still keep these titles in our everyday conversation. We also hang onto the symbols of power that they express. But here, in Jesus, we see a different kind of power. His power is expressed in his complete submission so as to be of service to all. If you had been present at this conversation between Jesus and Pilate, you would have been excused for thinking that Pilate was the king. His clothes were more fitting for a king than the ragged, bloodstained cloak that Jesus wore. We can be so easily deceived by externals. The clothes that a person wears are only the outer shell. What is in the heart is hidden!

John expressed it most powerfully. The dialogue between Jesus and Pilate took place inside the palace away from the crowds. Pilate asked three questions: *First*, Are you a king? Jesus replies by trying to establish the terms of the debate: Is this a trumped-up charge of treason or are you serious? Do you believe that I have committed treason?

*Second*: What have you done? Jesus replies that his kingdom is not political. It does not belong to this world. If it did belong to this world then my followers would rise up in revolt.

The *third* question repeats the first: 'So you are a king?' Jesus agrees and states more positively that his kingship consists of bearing witness to the truth. For John, the 'truth' is God's reality that is revealed in the person of Jesus. Jesus' kingship means being lifted up on the cross to draw all to himself. In this way he shows by his actions more than his words that God is love.

This gospel presents the confrontation between a confused and questioning Pilate and Jesus the King, not in the royal attitudes of this world, but enunciating strongly his clear claim to a kingdom of a different kind. Pilate's words demonstrate arrogance and curiosity as he sneers: What is truth? Jesus replies firmly and unflinchingly: You would have no power if it were not given to you from above! He is uncompromising yet firm in his replies. *Noel Mansfield, msc*
