Gospel Reflection

Good News Luke 3:10-18



Today's texts invite us to rejoice. This is the way to wait for the Lord's coming. Vigilance presupposes being attentive to the signs of the times.

What must we do? How do we get ourselves ready? We are getting ready for the birth of the Lord into our world again this Christmas. The prophet Zephaniah gives us the key to our preparation. "Shout with joy, Zion; Israel, shout aloud! Rejoice, exult with all your heart. ... The Lord your God is in your midst. ... He will exult with joy over you; he will renew you by his love." The prophet's whole message is one of rejoicing because God is already in our midst.

As any parents will tell you, there is great rejoicing as the time of their child's birth draws near. It was the same for Mary at this time. She and Joseph were preparing to travel to Bethlehem. It does not really matter where the child is born. The central desire in their hearts is for the child to be born. There is restlessness both in the child and the mother. Even the child lets the mother know it is about to be born.

John tells people very simply what to do. His answers are direct. We all know what we must do. It is written on our hearts. We need only to be reassured that God is with us. He is binding himself even more closely to the human family by a bond that can never be broken.

Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, our liberating God, you are ever faithful to your promises and you remain always close to your people. You sent your Son, Jesus, to set us free. He came to bring wholeness and healing to all. Help us to be free of all that binds us: our addictions to gossip, junk food, judging others, our narrowness of vision, our personal chains, and all that imprisons us in life. May we help everyone in our community to be free, to dream and to be creative, to be full of life and hope and joy. Fr Noel Mansfield, msc

Plenary Council 2020

'More than ever before, we need the guidance and inspiration of the Holy Spirit as we engage in the task of renewing and re-energising the Church. We need a new Pentecost that will move us from decay to growth, from chaos to harmony, from disillusionment to joy. We need to find new fresh ways of being church that reflect authentically the person and message of Jesus and empower our people with fresh hope.'



Spoken by Bishop Vincent Long on Pentecost Sunday as he launched the Plenary Council in his diocese of Parramatta. These words speak clearly to us here in Adelaide also.

The Second Vatican Council recommended that the Church should be more participatory in its processes, involving **all the baptised** in the Church. In light of this, the Bishops of Australia have invited all who are connected in any way with our Australian Catholic Church to participate in the **Plenary Council**. We are all being invited to consider how we can be the Jesus' presence and witness in our contemporary Australian society and discern the future that God is calling us to as a Church.

The first meeting of Plenary Council 2020 will be held in **Adelaide** from October 4-10, 2020. It will be an exciting new event for the Catholic Church in Australia. Preparation for this gathering involves **all of us** being invited to participate in a process of **listening and dialogue**.

Here in our Hindmarsh – Findon Parish we will begin this process during Advent. Over the coming weeks several parishioners will be invited to give a brief reflection at Mass on the question to which all associated with the Catholic Church in Australia are being asked to respond. This will provide relevant information for the Plenary Council. This question is

"What do you think God is asking of us in Australia at this time?"

In February next year all parishioners will be invited to gatherings in which you can participate in small groups to share and listen to others around this question. Already thousands of responses from across our country have been received by the Council: it is important that **each one of us** has the opportunity to speak and be listened to as we share our experiences and hopes for our Church. May we all be open to God's Spirit during this process.

Prayer for a New Archbishop.
Apostolic Administrator Bishop Gregory O'Kelly SJ has made available the following Prayer Cards. The Prayer Cards are aimed at invoking the Lord that a new Bishop might be appointed to lead the Church of Adelaide and of Port Pirie, in the ways of the Gospel. Please collect your Prayer Card from the church entrance and join us in daily prayer for this intention.

The Advent wreath, four candles on a wreath of evergreen, is shaped in a perfect circle to symbolize the eternity of God. Four candles, one for each week in Advent, symbolize the coming of Christ, with one larger white candle in the middle as the Christ candle.

During each Sunday of the Advent season, we focus on one of the four virtues Jesus brings us: Hope, Love, Joy and Peace. The Christ candle is lit on Christmas Eve or Christmas Day reminding Christians that Jesus is the light of the world. The order and exact wording vary among churches, but the wreath continually reminds us of whom we are called to be as followers of Jesus.
