For more than 60 years a special celebration of the Eucharist has been held in St Francis Xavier's Cathedral to celebrate Australia Day. We come together to celebrate and give thanks for this wonderful country and to recognise the richness and diversity of the people who call Australia home. All are welcome to join us on this special occasion.

Gospel Reflection

Wedding Feast of Cana John 2:1-12

We move into the symbolic language of John. The miracle at Cana was the first of the signs in John's gospel. Jesus did not perform his miracles so that people might look to him. No, he performed them so that His Father would be glorified. In this scene, Jesus blessed a marriage with an abundance of wine. In the ordinary events of our lives, God is blessing us with abundance if only we have our eyes open to recognize his presence.

Jesus tells the servants to fill the water jars for the Jewish rites of purification. (v.6) From now on, religion will no longer be based on the law and constant ablutions or on the observance of precepts followed under fear of punishment and guilt. That is to be swept away in this new dispensation.

The prophet Isaiah had already foretold this when he spoke to the people who felt weary, abandoned and despairing. He spoke of the 'new' things the Lord had in store for them: a new name and a new covenant (62:6). He used marriage symbolism to recall the tenderness, intimacy and affection of God's new relationship with his people. God is not a severe and despotic God but rather the bridegroom and the friend who loves with tenderness and passion and who delights in the love of his people.

John takes up that theme. He presents the first of his signs in the context of a marriage feast. 'Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding (v. 3). Or perhaps Jesus is the one who is inviting us to know him. God can reveal himself in a church or on a mountaintop. Here he reveals himself at a wedding and in the presence of his friends.

God was preparing his people for a celebration, a new alliance. What was presented as a symbol will become full reality when the hour comes (v. 4). This is the new relationship of God with his people, as different from the previous one as water is from wine.

Do we recognize God's abundant blessings in the ordinary events of our own life?

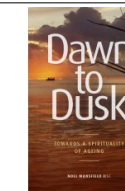
