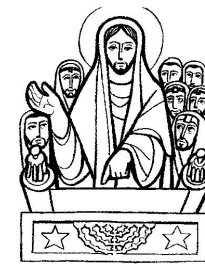

Gospel Reflection

"The Spirit has Anointed Me" Luke 1:1-4; 4:14-21

Today, we have an insight into Jesus' own experience of the Spirit of God. He has experienced baptism by John. Now, in the power of that Spirit, he came to his home town, Nazareth, to proclaim the Good News. He proclaims to those in the synagogue that he was the fulfillment of God's promises. "These words of the prophet Isaiah are being fulfilled even as you listen." He is speaking about his own experience. He knows that the Holy Spirit is upon him and has anointed him for a special mission.

The reading from the Book of Nehemiah is an excellent backdrop to the Gospel scene. It records the solemn proclamation of the Word of God that took place after the return from exile in Babylon. The picture is very specific. It is a moment of reverence and solemnity. The Word of God had been closed to the people for many generations while they were in exile. Now Ezra steps forward to proclaim it at great length. To enhance the sense of occasion, he is on a high platform; the attention of the people is fixed on him.

Jesus can be seen in this way in the synagogue at Nazareth. The power of the Spirit is on him; his reputation has spread. He is teaching as he usually does on the Sabbath and he stands up to read. The scroll of the prophet Isaiah is given to him and he opens it at a very special place. Some have called this the Magna Carta of liberation theology. Jesus' ministry of liberation is directed to the whole person. He is not concerned with politics. He is concerned for those who reach out to God in their need.

As long as injustice and oppression still flourish, Jesus' ministry of liberation is incomplete. "All eyes in the synagogue are fixed on him." Keep your eyes fixed on Jesus. His experience is the key to our understanding of God's call in our own lives. Jesus is the Word of God.

Note: If you have attended a Child Safe Environments or RAN training within the past 3 years you do not need to attend a Volunteer Briefing

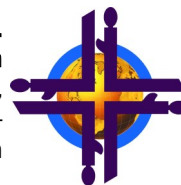

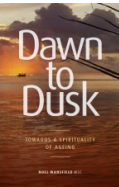
