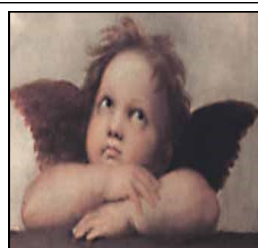

**Gospel Reflection**

**Double Standard** Jer 1:4-5,17-19; 1 Cor 12:31-13:13; Luke 4:21-30

When Jesus comes to his hometown, he receives a very warm welcome. He is the local boy who has made good. That soon changes. He is recognised: "Isn't this the son of Joseph? We know his family well. How could he have such powers and such knowledge of the Scriptures?"

Jesus confronts the people. He aligns himself with Elijah and Elisha, two great Jewish prophets. They were sent to the Israelite people; but some of their most significant miracles were worked outside the chosen people. Elijah was sent to a widow in a town far removed from the country of Israel. This woman accepted him as a prophet. Elijah's own people wanted to murder him because he challenged them. Elisha worked a miracle for the commander of a conquering army. He cured the army commander of leprosy. The prophet wanted Israel's King to submit to this conqueror and live. No one listened to his warning.

The prophet Jeremiah hears God telling him he has been chosen. God's choice of Jeremiah would lead him to stand up against all those in authority. A prophet is one who speaks the truth as he sees it, one who dares to question the unwritten assumptions out of which a group operates. Prophets are marginalised and crucified now as always, in both civil and religious societies. Hence the command of God to him: "I have appointed you as a prophet to the nations. So now brace yourself for action."

As Catholics, we have so often seen ourselves as the only true church. Do you still operate out of this assumption? Are you prepared to accept that God speaks in many and varied ways, to people of all races and cultures and creeds. Jesus certainly knew that. He challenges us today to look at our church and its structures. He challenges us to allow the Spirit to blow away all the cobwebs that have accumulated in our museum/church! Jesus was prepared to question! Why can't we do the same?

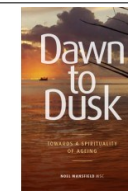
